<u>Position Title:</u> Contract Therapist

Position Description: LCSW, LMFT, LPC or LPA to provide therapeutic services to child sexual

abuse survivors and their families. Modalities include individual therapy, group therapy, and/or family therapy and clinician will utilize evidenced-based, trauma-informed treatment approaches. Clinician might also be involved in crisis intervention, consultation with multidisciplinary team members, and civil and criminal court testimony. Clinician will be able to

offer therapy sessions after school hours and/or on weekends.

Job Duties:

- Provides individual therapy, group therapy, and/or family therapy to child sexual abuse survivors and their non-offending family members using evidence-based treatment approaches.
- Completes individualized treatment plans.
- Measures treatment progress by assessing improvement using clinical assessment tools.
- Completes documentation and invoices regarding therapeutic sessions and submits these to the CAC.
- Consults with multidisciplinary team partners when necessary.
- Provides fact witness testimony in civil and/or criminal court proceedings on rare occasions.

Qualifications:

- Master's Degree in a field related to mental health, such as Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, Counseling, or Clinical Psychology.
- Candidate must possess full Clinical Licensure (LCSW, LMFT, LPC, or LPA [with independent practice]).
- Candidate must have knowledge of abuse populations, trauma, attachment, child development, crisis intervention, and psychotherapeutic techniques.



- Candidate should have training and experience in at least one traumainformed, evidenced-based modality, such as TF-CBT, EMDR, or CFTSI.
- Candidate should have the ability to communicate well orally and in writing.
- Candidates must pass a criminal background check and a DFPS check.
- Clinicians who are fluent in both Spanish and English and have an indepth awareness of Hispanic culture are preferred.
