HCR's TRIAD Child Sex Trafficking (CST) Program operates a 24/7 hotline for first responders in Harris County as a gateway to provide comprehensive care coordination. TRIAD CST serves minor victims (under 18) of child sexual exploitation in the Harris County region. This Care Coordination program serves as a means to foster collaboration among law enforcement, child welfare, juvenile justice and various service providers with the goal of intervening with and assisting child sex trafficking survivors.
