## Spirit of Fall Sporting Clay Tournament Information

- Course & Stations
  - The Sporting clays course is composed of 12 stations
    - Each station will be staffed with an experienced referee who will handle scoring & ammo
  - 72 targets would format each station to throw 3 pairs (6 shots)
  - An additional Mulligan station will be available with up to 4 additional pairs
- Team Flurry
  - A Team Flurry station will be set up for team participation
- Golf Carts
  - Greater Houston Sports Club (GHSC) will provide the golf carts (included with your registration), and your course/station assignment will be noted on the cart
- Registration
  - Shooters will check-in with GHSC staff, where they will sign an electronic waiver and receive their station/cart assignment map along with a "No Alcohol" wristband
  - GHSC will give a safety briefing to all shooters a few minutes prior to a shotgun start
  - Shooters will need to sign an additional waiver for The Children's Assessment Center Foundation
- Scores
  - GHSC staff will be staged on the course to collect scorecards
  - Individual & Team scores will be displayed on screens at the pavilion
  - Award categories will include Men's HOA, Women's HOA, Top Three Teams & Top Team Flurry
- Important Information
  - GHSC does not offer any gun rentals
  - Eye/Ear protection is required on all shooting venues

## Safety Rules

The following rules apply to ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS. Any violation may result in removal from the facility and/or suspension of Membership at the Management's discretion.

1. It is the Member or Guest Shooter's responsibility to observe gun safety rules at all times and to ensure that his or her guns are in proper working order.
2. While on any shooting venue, all shooters and spectators must wear eye and ear protection at all times.
3. Never mix gauges while shooting. Pick one gauge to shoot at a time. **CHECK YOUR AMMO POUCH BEFORE SHOOTING**
4. 7.5, 8, or 9 shot only.
5. Always check your breech for obstructions before loading.
6. Never load more than two shells at one time.
7. Guns must be open and empty unless in the designated shooting position.
8. Always make sure the gun is open and empty before leaving the designated shooting position.
9. A yellow chain across a shooting station indicates that the station is being serviced and unavailable. Please move on to another station.
10. The speed limit for all motorized vehicles on GHSC property is 10 mph.
11. Neither alcohol nor illegal drugs are permitted on any shooting venue at any time.
12. Shooting after consumption of alcohol or drugs (other than prescription medicine that does not impair a shooter's ability to perform safely) is strictly prohibited.
